Position Rationale

Under the direction of Foreman, the job of Rubber Tire Loader Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of a Loader. This position operates loaders equipment with front-mounted hydraulically powered bucket or scoop which is used to transport aggregate or other materials, feed hoppers or chutes, and/or stockpile aggregates in water and sewer installation projects.

Position Accountabilities

Equipment Operation:

- Perform daily maintenance and safety checks of equipment; perform routine cleaning and maintenance to ensure the smooth operation of a loader.
- Understand and follow directions from the supervisor as required by the work area.
- Operate a loader, controls to lower, tilt bucket, and drive forward to force bucket into bulk material; move a lever to raise and tilt bucket when filled or to dump material.
- Operate a loader on public or private roadways, maintaining proper awareness of one’s surroundings.

- Operate other heavy equipment and other construction-related duties as required.

Technical Knowledge:

- Knowledge of loader operation and other heavy equipment.
- Knowledge of road construction materials, road construction processes and industry requirements.
- A sound understanding of the issues involving ground disturbance, computerized controls /electronics.

Customer Service:

- Project a professional image in dealing with the public, internal and external clients, suppliers, and subcontractors.
- Model a clear understanding of who the internal and external customers of the Volker Stevin Group of Companies are.
- Demonstrate a “can do,” problem solving approach to all inquiries and concerns.
- Know when to escalate an issue for immediate response.

Work Environment / Conditions:

- Work is performed in an outdoor setting, which could include inclement weather, heat, and humidity.

- Ability to work in adverse weather conditions.
- Physically capable of repetitively lifting and carrying at least 25 lbs. regularly.
